A. The Holy Spirit helps Jesus to be seen in us.

John 16:14 (GNT) "He will give me glory."

1. Always points us to Jesus.
2. Gives us power to live a holy life.
3. Drawing people's attention to Christ by:
 - i. Courtesy. **(Titus 3:2 (GW))**
 - ii. Becoming unoffendable.
 - iii. Showing respect. **(1 Peter 2:17)**
 - iv. Showing sympathy. **(Col. 3:12)**
 - v. Speaking honestly. **(Proverbs 24:26)**

B. The Holy Spirit Convicts. (John 16:8)

1. Holy Spirit conviction it is not:
 - A guilty conscience.
2. Holy Spirit Conviction is:
 - i. realizing the true loathsomeness of sin. **(Isaiah 6:5)**
 - ii. understanding how our sin dishonors God. **(Psalms 51:4)**

C. The Holy Spirit reminds us of our advocate.

1. Jesus **(John 2:1 & 2)**
2. He is both sacrifice and advocate.

(1 John 1:9 NLT) *But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.*

D. The Holy Spirit is our Guide: (John 16:13)

1. He knows our future.
2. Three primary means to guide us:
 - i. The word **Ps 119:105**
 - ii. God's voice **(John 10:27)**
 - iii. Our thoughts **(Psalm 37:23)**

E. The Holy Spirit Manages our Moods. (Romans 8:6)

1. Helps us to manage our emotions **(Romans 12:1–2)**
2. Give control to the Holy Spirit Daily **(Romans 6:13)**
3. Don't let anger get out of control. **(James 1:20)**
4. Stay focused on the things you can control, not on the things you can't control. **(Psalm 56:3)**

F. The Holy Spirit manifestations supported by God's word.

1. All encounters conform to God's Word.
(1 Corinthians 2:14)
2. Hunger to know the Word.
 - i. Day of Pentecost...This is that...the Prophet Joel. **Acts 2:16–21 (NIV)**
